What is an Apprenticeship Program and how does it benefit me?

Registered Apprenticeship is a program that combines on-the-job training with related classroom instruction. Basically, we help you become a **highly skilled Journeyworker and we pay you for it! Benefits include:**

- ➤ Industry issued, nationally recognized credentials

The bottom line is that not only do you become a highly skilled Journeyworker you also earn a nationally recognized credential! And, of course, **MONEY**, **MONEY**, **MONEY**!!!!!

- ➤ Get your CDL license get a \$1.00 per hour raise!
- ➤ Get your Applicator's license get a \$1.00 per hour raise!
- > Get your equipment certification get a \$1.00 per hour raise! (for hours running that equipment)

If you had your CDL license + \$400

If you were a Licensed Applicator + \$400

If you were a Certified Equipment Operator + \$400

If you were a Certified Arborist + \$400

If you were a Certified Arborist Utility Specialist + \$400

If you owned your own Chainsaw + \$120

If you are a Journeyworker + \$400

Under the <u>Apprenticeship Program</u> you will become a <u>Certified Journeyworker</u> which will include your Class A CDL License with Air Brakes, Certified Applicator's License and a Certified Equipment Operator. At this storm you would have earned at least <u>\$1,200 more!</u>
